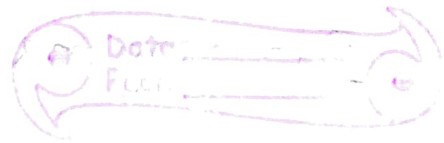

The ship sailed in adverse weather condition. (Adjective)

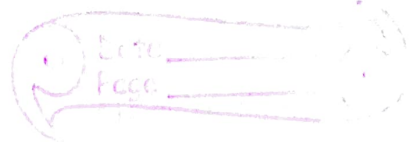
He is averse to hard work.
